



On the marriage **certificate** portion of the form(s), in addition to the **signature** of the person conducting the marriage, the form now requires that the name be **printed**;

The form(s) **certificate** requirement for:

“A signed statement by the county clerk or a deputy county clerk of the county in which the license was issued that the marriage certificate was recorded. The statement shall indicated the name of the county and the date the marriage certificate was recorded.”

is replaced with:

“A signed statement indicating that the marriage certificate was recorded in the county in which it was filed. The statement shall also include the title of the county clerk or deputy clerk of the county in which the certificate was filed and indicate the date the marriage certificate was recorded.”

Finally, SB 5 GA removes the requirement that a Social Security number be provided by the parties and recorded with the Cabinet for Health and Family Services agency responsible for child support enforcement.

### **Part III: Fiscal Explanation, Bill Provisions, and Estimated Cost**

**The fiscal impact on local governments will be nil to minimal.** Some minor administrative procedural adjustments will need to be made. However, the content of the forms (by statute) are provided and “prescribed by the Department for Libraries and Archives”.
