

On page 1, beginning on line 5 and continuing through line 18, delete subsection (1) in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"(1) The Public Service Commission shall consist of five (5) members as follows:

(a) Three (3) members appointed by the Governor:

- 1. One (1) of whom shall be a licensed attorney who has actively practiced law in the Commonwealth for at least seven (7) years;
- 2. Two (2) of whom shall have education or training, and five (5) years of actual experience, in one (1) or more of the following fields:
  - a. Economics;
  - b. Engineering;
  - c. Accounting;
  - d. Finance;
  - e. Utility regulation, operation, or management;
  - f. Pipeline or utility infrastructure safety;
  - g. Business management; or
  - h. Environmental management; and

(b) Two (2) members appointed by the Auditor of Public Accounts, who shall have the qualifications required under paragraph (a)1. or 2. of this subsection."; and

On page 6, beginning on line 7 and continuing through line 16, delete Section 4 in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"➔Section 4. KRS 278.070 is amended to read as follows:

- (1) The officer who appointed the commissioner~~[Governor]~~ may remove the~~[any]~~ commissioner for cause, after giving him or her a copy of the charges against him or her and an opportunity of being publicly heard in person or by counsel in his or her own defense upon not less than ten (10) days' notice.
- (2) If a commissioner is removed, the officer who made the appointment~~[Governor]~~ shall file in the office of the Secretary of State a complete statement of all charges against the commissioner and his or her findings thereon, and a complete record of the proceedings.
- (3) Any commissioner so removed may bring action in the proper court to determine whether or not he or she was legally removed in accordance with this section."; and

and

On page 20, line 7, delete "Governor" and insert "Auditor of Public Accounts" in lieu thereof.
