

KENTUCKY GENERAL ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT FORM

On page 7, after line 9, insert the following:

"➔SECTION 4. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 237 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

(1) The School Body Armor fund is hereby created as a separate trust fund in the State Treasury, to be administered by the Kentucky Department of Education.

(a) Amounts deposited in the School Body Armor fund shall be used only for the purpose of purchasing body armor for students enrolled in elementary and secondary schools in Kentucky.

(b) The School Body Armor fund shall consist of amounts received from each sale of firearms, whether through a federally licensed firearms dealer or a private sale.

(c) For each sale of a firearm, one hundred dollars (\$100) shall be remitted to the School Body Armor fund.

(2) (a) Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, School Body Armor fund amounts not expended at the close of a fiscal year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward into the next fiscal year.

(b) Any interest earnings of the School Body Armor fund shall become a part of the fund and shall not lapse.

(c) Moneys deposited in the fund are hereby appropriated for the purposes set forth in
