17		Beginning on page 2, line 15, and continuing through page 4, line 12, delete Section 2 in its			
18	entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:				
19		"→Section 2. KRS 304.17-316 is amended to read as follows:			
20	(1)	(1) The term "mammogram" shall mean an x-ray examination of the breast using equipment			
21		dedi	cated specifically for mammography, including, but not limited to, the x-ray tube, filter,		
22		com	pression device, screens, film, and cassettes, with two (2) views of each breast and with		
23		an a	verage radiation exposure at the current recommended level as set forth in guidelines of		
24		the	American College of Radiology, and digital mammography including breast		
25	tomosynthesis. The term "breast tomosynthesis" means a radiologic procedure that				
26	involves the acquisition of projection images over the stationary breast to produce cross-				
27		<u>sect</u>	ional digital three-dimensional images of the breast.		
28	(2)	(a)	All insurers issuing individual health insurance policies in this Commonwealth that		
29			provide coverage on an expense-incurred basis for surgical services for a mastectomy		
30			and that are delivered, issued for delivery, amended, or renewed on or after October		
31			15, 1990, shall also provide coverage for low-dose mammography screening for		
32			persons who have no sign or symptom of breast cancer and when performed on		

1 dedicated equipment which meets the guidelines established by the American College 2 of Radiology and upon self-referral or on referral by a health care practitioner acting 3 within the scope of the practitioner's licensure. The coverage shall make available one 4 (1) screening mammogram to persons age thirty-five (35) through thirty-nine (39); 5 one (1) mammogram every two (2) years for persons ages forty (40) through fortynine (49); and one (1) mammogram per year for a person fifty (50) years of age and 6 7 over and may be limited to a benefit of fifty dollars (\$50) per screening mammogram. 8 Any deductibles and coinsurance factors shall be no less favorable than for coverage 9 for physical illness generally.

10 All insurers issuing individual health insurance policies in this Commonwealth that (b) 11 provide coverage on an expense-incurred basis for surgical services for a mastectomy 12 and that are delivered, issued for delivery, amended, or renewed on or after July 14, 13 2000, shall also provide coverage for mammograms, performed on dedicated equipment that meets the guidelines established by the American College of 14 15 Radiology, for any covered person, regardless of age, who has been diagnosed with 16 breast disease upon referral by a health care practitioner acting within the scope of the 17 practitioner's licensure. The coverage provided under this paragraph shall be subject 18 to the same annual deductibles or coinsurance established for other coverages within 19 the policy.

20 (3) The mammogram shall be performed by a Kentucky State Certified General Certificate 21 Radiographer or an American Registry of Radiologic Technology Registered Radiographer, 22 interpreted by a qualified radiologist, and performed under the direction of a person 23 licensed to practice medicine and certified by the American Board of Radiology. The 24 facility performing the examination and the health care practitioner who ordered it shall 25 follow federal laws relating to the notification of mammography exam results and 26 maintaining medical records[Two (2) copies of the mammogram report shall be sent to the health care practitioner who ordered it, one (1) copy of which shall be given to the patient. 27

1		In case of self-referral, one (1) copy of the mammogram report shall be given to the patient
2		upon request. The mammography film shall be retained by the facility performing the
3		examination in accordance with guidelines of the American College of Radiology].
4	(4)	Effective July 15, 1990, any facility in which mammograms are performed for
5		reimbursement under this section, KRS 304.18-098, 304.32-1591, or 304.38-1935 shall
6		meet current criteria of the American College of Radiology Mammography Accreditation
7		Program."; and
8		Amend the title to read as follows: "AN ACT relating to providing breast density
9	info	rmation and evidence-based breast cancer screening.".
