

1 AN ACT relating to public protection.

2 ***Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

3 ➔Section 1. KRS 61.365 is amended to read as follows:

4 The following persons who are employed by the federal government as law enforcement  
5 or investigative officers who have the power of arrest and who are residents of the  
6 Commonwealth of Kentucky shall be deemed peace officers and shall have the same  
7 powers and duties of any other peace officer in the Commonwealth, except that they shall  
8 not be required to serve process unless permitted to do so by their respective agencies:

- 9 (1) Federal Bureau of Investigation special agents;
- 10 (2) United States Secret Service special agents;
- 11 (3) United States Marshal's service deputies;
- 12 (4) Drug Enforcement Administration special agents;
- 13 (5) Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms special agents;
- 14 (6) United States Forest Service special agents and law enforcement officers;
- 15 (7) Special agents and law enforcement officers of the Office of the Inspector General  
16 of the United States Department of Agriculture;
- 17 (8) United States Customs Service special agents;~~and~~
- 18 (9) United States National Park Service law enforcement rangers; ***and***

19 ***(10) United States Mint Police of the United States Department of the Treasury:***

20 ***(a) On the portion of United States Highway 31W that is located within the***  
21 ***borders of the Fort Knox Military Reservation;***

22 ***(b) Within a local jurisdiction, upon the written request of the head of the local***  
23 ***law enforcement agency identifying a specific event and time frame for***  
24 ***which assistance is requested; and***

25 ***(c) Within the Commonwealth, upon the written request of the commissioner of***  
26 ***the Department of Kentucky State Police identifying a specific event and***  
27 ***time frame for which assistance is requested.***
