| 19 | (2) A governing body shall not limit or restrict the enforcement of federal |
| 20 | immigration laws to less than the full extent permitted by federal law. |
| 21 | (3) If a governing body violates this section, a person lawfully domiciled in Kentucky |
| 22 | may bring an action to compel the governing body to comply with this section. |
| 23 | (4) If a court finds that a governing body knowingly or intentionally violated |
| 24 | subsection (1) or (2) of this section, the court may enjoin the violation. |
| 25 | (5) Every law enforcement agency shall provide each law enforcement officer with a |

- 2 (6) This section shall be enforced without regard to race, religion, gender, ethnicity,
