2	Be it	enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 337 IS CREATED TO
4	REA	D AS FOLLOWS:
5	<u>(1)</u>	An employer with fifty (50) or more employees shall provide six (6) weeks of paid
6		leave for an employee who gives birth to a child if the employee has been
7		employed by the employer for at least one (1) year.
8	<u>(2)</u>	Paid leave under this section shall:
9		(a) Be provided irrespective of the employer's leave policies; and
10		(b) Not be provided for the birth of a child by a surrogate, adoption of a child,
11		or paternity leave.
12	<u>(3)</u>	An employee may voluntarily waive the paid leave required by this section by:
13		(a) Returning to work before the six (6) weeks have elapsed; or
14		(b) Declining, in writing, to accept the paid leave.
15	<u>(4)</u>	The secretary of the Labor Cabinet may promulgate administrative regulations
16		that he or she deems necessary to implement this section.
