

1 AN ACT relating to computation of time in state administrative bodies.

2 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

3 ➔SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 12 IS CREATED TO
4 READ AS FOLLOWS:

5 *Every organizational unit, department, division, branch, section, unit, office, and*
6 *administrative body in state government shall compute time as follows:*

7 *(1) In computing any period of time prescribed or allowed by order of court, or by*
8 *any applicable statute or administrative regulation, the day of the act, event, or*
9 *default after which the designated period of time begins to run is not to be*
10 *included. The last day of the period so computed is to be included, unless it is a*
11 *Saturday, a Sunday, a legal holiday, or a day on which the public office in which*
12 *a document is required to be filed is actually and legally closed, in which event*
13 *the period runs until the end of the next day which is not a Saturday, Sunday,*
14 *legal holiday, or day on which the public office is closed. When the period of time*
15 *prescribed or allowed is less than seven (7) days, intermediate Saturdays,*
16 *Sundays, and legal holidays shall be excluded in the computation.*

17 *(2) When a statute, administrative regulation, or order of court requires an act to be*
18 *accomplished either a certain time before an event or a certain time before the*
19 *day on which an event occurs, the day of the event shall be excluded in*
20 *computing the time. If the day thereby computed on which or by which the act is*
21 *required to be accomplished falls on a Saturday, a Sunday, a legal holiday, or a*
22 *day on which the public office in which the act is required to be completed is*
23 *actually and legally closed, the act may be accomplished on the next day which is*
24 *not a Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday, or day on which the public office is closed.*
