6	<u>(1)</u>	If a patient's mammogram demonstrates dense breast tissue, a person who
7	L	provided the mammography services in the Commonwealth shall provide
8	<u>!</u>	notification to the patient that includes but is not limited to the following
9	<u>i</u>	information in the summary of the written report of the results sent directly to a
10	L	patient:
11	<u>-</u>	'Your mammogram shows that your breast tissue is dense. Dense breast tissue is
12	<u>1</u>	very common and is not abnormal. However, dense breast tissue can make it
13	<u> 1</u>	harder to find cancer through a mammogram. Also, dense breast tissue may
14	<u>i</u>	ncrease your risk for breast cancer. This information about the result of your
15	<u>!</u>	nammogram is given to you to raise your awareness. Use this information to
16	<u>4</u>	discuss with your health care provider whether other supplemental tests in
17	<u>4</u>	addition to your mammogram may be appropriate for you, based on your
18	<u>i</u>	ndividual risk. A report of your results was sent to your ordering physician. If
19	1	you are self-referred, a report of your results was sent to you in addition to this
20	<u>s</u>	summary.''
21	<u>(2)</u>	As used in this section, "dense breast tissue" means heterogeneously or
22	<u> </u>	extremely dense breast tissue as defined in nationally recognized guidelines or
23	<u>s</u>	systems for breast imaging reporting of mammography screening, including but
24	<u>1</u>	not limited to the breast imaging reporting and data system established by the
25	<u> 4</u>	American College of Radiology. If, after the effective date of this Act, new terms
26	<u>c</u>	are defined in revised guidelines or systems for breast imaging reporting of
27	1	nammography screening and the Department for Public Health determines that

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1	those new terms are more appropriate for the purposes of the information
2	required to be provided under this section, the Department for Public Health may
3	update the definition of dense breast tissue under this subsection to use those new
4	terms by administrative regulation.
