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1	AN ACT relating to pesticide application notice requirements.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 217 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) "Application" means pesticide application by any means, including
7	application aerially or by ground;
8	(b) ''Pest'' has the same meaning as in KRS 217.544;
9	(c) "Pesticide" has the same meaning as in KRS 217.544; and
10	(d) "Residential area" means any land that is zoned for purposes other than
11	agricultural purposes and that has a residential density of one (1) or more
12	residence per acre.
13	(2) Any state or local government entity that engages in or directs the application of
14	a pesticide in a residential area for the purposes of controlling disease-bearing
15	pest populations shall, no later than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the
16	application:
17	(a) Directly notify, either in person or by telephone, the county judge/executive
18	for the county in which the application will occur and the mayor or the
19	highest elective executive officer of any city in which the application will
20	occur; and
21	(b) Give public notice in the county in which the application will occur, using
22	all reasonable means to disseminate information required under this
23	paragraph as widely as possible. The public notice shall include but not be
24	limited to public or online posting to the entity's Web site of:
25	1. A copy of any United States Environmental Protection Agency permit
26	or other permit under which the pesticide will be applied;
27	2. Any technical information, if available, about the pesticide being

1		applied, including the source of the technical information and its
2		publication date;
3		3. The projected area over which the application of the pesticide will
4		<u>occur;</u>
5		4. The time and predicted duration of the application period; and
6		5. Contact information for the state or local government entity or entities
7		engaging in or directing the application of the pesticide.
8	<u>(3)</u>	The state or local government entity required to give notice under subsection (2)
9		of this section shall give additional public notice every seven (7) days that the
10		application of pesticide continues from the original application date, and it shall
11		also give notice when the application has terminated.
12	<u>(4)</u>	If multiple state or local government entities coordinate to engage in or direct the
13		application of a pesticide in a residential area for the purposes of controlling
14		disease-bearing pest populations, then the entities shall also coordinate to
15		determine which single entity shall provide the notices required under
16		subsections (2) and (3) of this section.
