

1           A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the United States Department of  
2 Veterans Affairs, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and Kentucky's  
3 United States Congressional delegation to take the appropriate steps to get the approval  
4 and funding necessary for the construction of a veterans' medical center in Radcliff,  
5 Kentucky.

6           WHEREAS, throughout the history of the Commonwealth, its sons and daughters  
7 have answered the nation's call to military service and have traversed the globe in defense  
8 of this great country; and

9           WHEREAS, Kentucky's veterans deserve all of the respect and admiration for their  
10 service that can be mustered, and in doing so the Commonwealth has an obligation to  
11 ensure access to the best-quality healthcare available; and

12           WHEREAS, Hardin and surrounding counties have a veteran population of over  
13 35,000; and

14           WHEREAS, Ireland Army Hospital is being reorganized as a "super clinic" and will  
15 no longer provide emergency room, inpatient, or surgery services for the military service  
16 members and veterans in the Hardin County area; and

17           WHEREAS, the United States Department of Veterans Affairs plans to replace the  
18 aging Robley Rex Medical Center in Louisville, Kentucky; and

19           WHEREAS, the city of Radcliff is offering to donate 50 acres of a vacant 147-acre  
20 parcel as a site for the long-planned replacement Veterans Medical Center; and

21           WHEREAS, Radcliff's proposed site has the advantage of being close to Fort Knox  
22 and the Radcliff Veterans Center nursing home facility; and

23           WHEREAS, Radcliff's proposed site would provide access to all veterans in the  
24 region, being in close proximity to Highway 31W, Interstate 65, KY 313, the Western  
25 Kentucky Parkway, the Bluegrass Parkway, and the Patriot Parkway; and

26           WHEREAS, an environmental study for the site has already been completed;

27           NOW, THEREFORE,

1 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the*  
2 *Commonwealth of Kentucky, the Senate concurring therein:*

3       ➔Section 1. The Kentucky General Assembly does hereby urge the United States  
4 Department of Veterans Affairs, the Governor of the Commonwealth, and Kentucky's  
5 United States Congressional delegation to take the necessary actions to get the approval  
6 and funding for the construction of a veterans' medical center in Radcliff, Kentucky.
