

1       A JOINT RESOLUTION applying for an Article V convention to propose  
2 amendments to the Constitution of the United States that impose fiscal restraints, and  
3 limit the power and jurisdiction of the federal government, and requesting Congress to  
4 similarly propose such amendments.

5       WHEREAS, the founders of the Constitution of the United States empowered state  
6 legislators to be guardians of liberty against future abuses of power by the federal  
7 government; and

8       WHEREAS, the federal government has created a crushing national debt through  
9 improper and imprudent spending; and

10      WHEREAS, the federal government has invaded the legitimate roles of the states  
11 through the manipulative process of federal mandates, most of which are unfunded to a  
12 great extent; and

13      WHEREAS, the federal government has ceased to live under a proper interpretation  
14 of the Constitution of the United States; and

15      WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of the states to protect the liberty of our people,  
16 particularly for the generations to come, by proposing amendments to the Constitution of  
17 the United States through a convention of the states under Article V of the Constitution  
18 for the purpose of restraining these and related abuses of power;

19      NOW, THEREFORE,

20 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

21      ➔Section 1. That the Congress of the United States is hereby petitioned to  
22 propose an amendment to the Constitution of the United States, for submission to the  
23 states for ratification, to impose fiscal restraints on the federal government and limit the  
24 federal government's power and jurisdiction.

25      ➔Section 2. That pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United States,  
26 the Legislature of the State of Kentucky, joins in the applications of the states of Georgia  
27 (SR 736, 2014), Florida (SM 476, 2014), Alaska (HJR 22, 2014), Alabama (HJR 112,

1       2015), Tennessee (SJ 67, 2016), Indiana (SJR 14, 2016), Oklahoma (SJR 4, 2016), and  
2       Louisiana (SCR 52, 2016), for a convention for the specific and exclusive purpose of  
3       proposing amendments to the Constitution of the United States limited to the purposes  
4       stated therein; provided, however, that the commissioners from Kentucky to the  
5       convention are expressly limited to consideration and support of amendments that impose  
6       fiscal restraints on the federal government, and amendments that limit the power and  
7       jurisdiction of the federal government, and no other amendments on any topic  
8       whatsoever.

9              ➔Section 3. That it is the express intention of the General Assembly that this  
10       application shall be aggregated with the subsequent applications of other states limited to  
11       the purposes identified in this application and with those applications of the above  
12       mentioned states.

13              ➔Section 4. That this application constitutes a continuing application in  
14       accordance with Article V of the Constitution of the United States until the legislatures of  
15       at least two-thirds of the several states have made applications for a similar convention  
16       under Article V, or the General Assembly acts to withdraw this application.

17              ➔Section 5. That the Secretary of State shall transmit certified copies of this Joint  
18       Resolution to the President, the Secretary of the United States Senate, the Speaker and  
19       Clerk of the United States House of Representatives, the presiding officer in each house  
20       of the legislature in each of the states in the union, and to the members of Kentucky's  
21       congressional delegation requesting their cooperation.
