3	WHEREAS, James Alexander Sherrill was born November 17, 1977, a native of
4	Ekron, Meade County, Kentucky, and he traversed these earthly bounds April 3, 2005;
5	and
6	WHEREAS, James A. Sherrill was the loving son of William Sherrill and Beatrice
7	Sherrill; he was the devoted fiancé of Stephanie Blevins; he was the caring brother of
8	Taneshia Sherrill of Louisville and William "B.J." Sherrill of Ekron; he was the beloved
9	grandson of James Earl and Edna Alexander of Ekron and the late William and Rosa
10	Sherrill; and he also leaves behind many other loving family members; and
11	WHEREAS, James A. Sherill graduated from Meade County High School in 1996,
12	where he participated in athletics; and he was a student at Elizabethtown Community
13	College; and
14	WHEREAS, James A. Sherrill enlisted in the Marines following high school; he
15	then continued his service to others by joining the Kentucky National Guard in July 2000;
16	and he was assigned to the Army National Guard's 2113th Transportation Company,
17	Paducah, Kentucky; and
18	WHEREAS, Sergeant James A. Sherrill was mobilized in December 2004 and
19	deployed to Southwest Asia in January 2005, bravely supporting Operation Iraqi
20	Freedom; and
21	WHEREAS, on April 3, 2005, the life of Sergeant James A. Sherrill ended
22	prematurely when an explosion occurred while he was escorting a convoy in an armored
23	vehicle in Bayji, Iraq; and
24	WHEREAS, Sergeant James A. Sherrill served his country with honor and
25	distinction; he was buried with full military honors; and he was posthumously awarded
26	the Purple Heart, the Bronze Star, the Good Conduct Medal, and the Iraq Campaign

1	WHEREAS, Sergeant James A. Sherrill was highly regarded by all who knew him
2	as a joyful, kind man who enjoyed helping others; and he was interested in pursuing a
3	career in law enforcement; and
4	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky has the highest respect for Sergeant
5	James A. Sherrill and is deeply grateful for the sacrifice he made for the freedom of all
6	Americans and to ensure the freedom of the Iraqi people; and
7	WHEREAS, the service and sacrifice of Sergeant James A. Sherrill deserves some
8	tangible remembrance, however inadequate it might be;
9	NOW, THEREFORE,
10	Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
11	→ Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 313
12	within Meade County, from the Hardin County line to the city of Brandenburg, as the
13	"Sergeant James A. Sherrill Memorial Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective
14	date of this Resolution, erect appropriate signs denoting this designation. This designation

shall supersede any previous designations established for this section of highway.
