A RESOLUTION condemning the rally taking place in Pike County of the
 Traditionalist Worker Party/Nationalist Front/National Socialist Movement on April 28 29, 2017.

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that all those in this Commonwealth treat equally
Kentuckians of every race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, and religion; and

6 WHEREAS, Kentucky, with its longstanding credo of "United We Stand, Divided
7 We Fall," has, since its founding, served as a testament to the undying principles of

WHEREAS, on April 28-29, 2017, members of the Traditionalist Worker Party, the
Nationalist Front, and the National Socialist Movement will hold a rally in Pike County;
and

WHEREAS, these groups are nothing more than racist, xenophobic, intolerant organizations that seek to spread their hateful ideology to the families of eastern Kentucky, and who have sought since their inception to foist their perverse beliefs on the public; and

WHEREAS, the members of the House of Representatives condemn this rally in Pike County, and stand in rightful solidarity against the Traditionalist Worker Party, the Nationalist Front, and the National Socialist Movement. In so doing, the members encourage all Kentuckians to join in speaking out against the oppressive philosophies espoused by these hate groups;
