4 Elliott Sr. and the late Virginia Smith Elliott; and

5 WHEREAS, a graduate of Franklin County High School in Winchester, Tennessee,
6 Dr. Elliott would go on to graduate from the University of Tennessee as a certified
7 veterinarian and proudly served at Crocker Animal Hospital for 25 years; and

9 where he had been part of mission trips around the world; and
