1	A RESOLUTION encouraging the federal government to create a system whereby
2	imported drugs must be tested and approved by the United States Food and Drug
3	Administration, thus ensuring the safe distribution of pharmaceuticals to American
4	consumers.
5	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of American healthcare consumers to have safe
6	and effective medications; and
7	WHEREAS, the costs of pharmaceuticals are a critical component of quality
8	healthcare; and
9	WHEREAS, proposals have been made to relax restrictions on the importation of
10	drugs in an attempt to lower costs; and
11	WHEREAS, counterfeit pharmaceuticals are a quickly growing threat to world
12	health; and
13	WHEREAS, the previous four commissioners of the United States Food and Drug
14	Administration (FDA) have joined in a bipartisan manner to state that the FDA does not
15	have the capability to ensure the safety and effectiveness of imported drugs; and
16	WHEREAS, the importation of unproven and potentially hazardous drugs can
17	threaten the lives of American consumers;
18	NOW, THEREFORE,
19	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
20	Commonwealth of Kentucky:
21	\Rightarrow Section 1. The members of this honorable body have a moral obligation to make
22	certain that the citizens of the Commonwealth are protected against unproven and
23	hazardous imported drugs.
24	\rightarrow Section 2. The federal government is encouraged to create a system whereby
25	imported drugs must be tested and approved by the United States Food and Drug
26	Administration, thus ensuring the safe distribution of pharmaceuticals to American

consumers.

Section 3. The Clerk of the House of Representatives shall transmit a copy of
this Resolution to each member of the Kentucky congressional delegation and to the
United States Food and Drug Administration, 10903 New Hampshire Avenue, Silver
Spring, MD 20993.
