10 Kentucky Legislature and as a Franklin County magistrate, completing her husband's term  
11 after his death; and

12           WHEREAS, Patricia Fannin was a member of Peaks Mill Christian Church; and

13           WHEREAS, Patricia Fannin, beloved wife, sister, mother, and grandmother,  
14 departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on January 25, 2017,  
15 leaving her family, friends, and all those whose lives she touched in solemn mourning;

17           WHEREAS, Patricia Fannin was preceded in death by her parents and her husband,  
18 Ira Fannin. She is survived by her daughters, Heather Craighead and her husband, Todd,  
19 and Jennifer Bradshaw and her husband, Chris; son, Benjamin Webster Fannin and his  
20 wife, Lida; sister, Wanda Johnson and her husband, Mike; grandchildren, Logan  
21 Craighead, Kathryn Craighead, Allen Bradshaw, Andrew Bradshaw, Leonard Fannin,  
22 Michael Fannin, and William Fannin; close family friend, "Uncle Doc" Douglas Newton;
