8	(2)	Eacl	n board of education shall appoint a superintendent of schools after receiving

11		vaca	ancy has occurred or will occur in the office of superintendent, except that when	
12		the l	poard determines a vacancy will not occur before six (6) months from the date	
13		of de	etermination, the board shall establish a screening committee at least ninety (90)	
14		days	before the first date on which the position may be filled.	
15	(3)	A sc	reening committee shall be composed of:

1		membership shall be increased to include one (1) minority parent. This
2		minority parent member shall be elected by the parents in an election
3		conducted by the local school board. Parents in the district shall be given
4		adequate notice of the date, time, place, and purpose of the election.
5	(4)	A local board of education may increase the screening committee membership to
6		include one (1) high school student enrolled in the school district, elected by his
7		or her peers in the district.
8	<u>(5)</u>	Prior to appointing a superintendent of schools, the board of education shall
9		consider the recommendations of the screening committee, but the board shall not
10		be required to appoint a superintendent from the committee's recommendations.
