

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Dr. David
2 "Doc" Warren Livingston.

4 Western Kentucky University, the University of Kentucky, and Ohio State University. He
5 taught high school and college music at WKU, and played professionally for half his life;

8 Livingston was a proud veteran and member of the jazz bands of the United States Army
9 and United States Air Force; and

11 of Heaven on February 18, 2017, leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives he
12 touched in solemn mourning; and

13 WHEREAS, Doc Livingston was preceded in death by his wife of 65 years, Joyce,
14 and his brother, Carl Blair Livingston. He is survived by his daughter, Pam Thurman and
15 her husband, Mike; son, Tim and his wife, Susan; granddaughters, Hannah Vanderpool
16 and her husband, Jonathan, Rachel Rigdon and her husband, Brendan, and Miriam Bott
17 and her husband, Nathan; nine great-grandchildren; and a host of other family members,
18 friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss his presence in their lives;
