

1 A RESOLUTION honoring St. Albert the Great Parish School.

2 WHEREAS, St. Albert the Great Parish School, a proud Catholic institution located
3 in Louisville, has always followed its mission of preparing students to be socially
4 responsible people with strong Catholic beliefs, practices, and values; guiding them to
5 respect diversity; and challenging them to excel academically and grow spiritually; and

6 WHEREAS, on March 4, 2017, the St. Baldrick's Foundation, a volunteer-powered
7 organization dedicated to raising money for children's cancer research, will host one of its
8 signature head-shaving events at St. Albert the Great Parish School; and

9 WHEREAS, this is the 15th year St. Albert the Great has hosted the event. This
10 year's goal is to raise \$44,000 by the end of 2017, and as of March 1 St. Albert has raised
11 over \$45,271, making it the first school in the world to reach \$1 million in donations; and

12 WHEREAS, this honorable body rightfully commends those schools that seek to
13 better their communities and the worlds in which their students will live, and in that spirit
14 the members thank the parish families, the administration, the faculty, and the students at
15 St. Albert the Great Parish School for their continuing support of the St. Baldrick's
16 Foundation, for all they have done to support children's cancer research, and for serving
17 as a shining jewel of the Louisville Catholic community;

19 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***

21 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate hereby honor St. Albert the Great Parish
22 School and grant them best wishes as they once again partner with the St. Baldrick's
23 Foundation to raise money for this worthy cause.
