5 WHEREAS, S.T. Wright served as a probation and parole officer and supervisor in
6 several Kentucky counties for 41 years. He was named Supervisor of the Year three
7 times, and the training center in Sandy Hook, Kentucky, is named in his honor; and

8 WHEREAS, S.T. Wright, beloved husband, father, grandfather, and brother,
9 departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on March 5, 2017,
10 leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

11 WHEREAS, S.T. Wright was preceded in death by his parents; his first wife,
12 Gladys Hall Wright; his second wife, Violet "Chick" Stumbo Hall Wright; and six
13 brothers. He is survived by his son, Samuel T. Wright III and his wife, Jennifer; daughter,
14 Tammie Wright Bentley and her husband, Randall; grandsons, Samuel J. Tilden Wright
15 IV, John Alexander Wright, and Baron Taft Bentley; loving companion, Elsie Adams;
16 and a host of other family members, friends, and loved ones who will dearly miss his
17 presence in their lives;
