

1 A RESOLUTION recognizing April as Limb Loss Awareness Month.

2 WHEREAS, there are approximately two million Americans living with limb
3 loss/difference; and

4 WHEREAS, over 500 Americans lose a limb each day; and

5 WHEREAS, 1,000 babies are born each year in the United States with congenital
6 limb difference; and

7 WHEREAS, studies show 60 percent of limb loss is preventable; and

8 WHEREAS, diabetes and peripheral vascular disease are the leading causes of limb
9 loss; and

10 WHEREAS, the number of amputations per day will double by 2050 unless a major
11 public awareness campaign is launched and key prevention initiatives are put in place;
12 and

13 WHEREAS, the Amputee Coalition of America provides education, outreach,
14 advocacy, and a National Limb Loss Information Center for the benefit of persons with
15 limb loss/difference, their families, and healthcare providers; and

16 WHEREAS, April is an appropriate month to designate as Limb Loss Awareness
17 Month as spring is a time of renewal and inspiration;

18 NOW, THEREFORE,

19 ***Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of***
20 ***Kentucky:***

21 ➔Section 1. The Senate hereby encourages all Kentucky's citizens to join in
22 recognizing the importance of Limb Loss Awareness Month and celebrating people with
23 limb loss and limb difference living full and productive lives, expressing gratitude to
24 caregivers who are a source of support and motivation, and saluting combat amputees
25 who have lost their limbs in service to this country.

26 ➔Section 2. April is hereby recognized as Limb Loss Awareness Month.
