

1 A RESOLUTION honoring the Simon Kenton High School girls' basketball team.

2 WHEREAS, after being defeated by Elizabethtown High School on February 17,
3 the Simon Kenton Lady Pioneers reeled off six wins in a row, including a victory over
4 Grant County in the 8th Region championship game to earn a berth in the 2017 St.
5 Elizabeth Healthcare/KHSAA Girls' Sweet Sixteen; and

6 WHEREAS, the Lady Pioneers, ably led by Coach Jeff Stowers, dispatched Oldham
7 and Anderson Counties before facing Grant County, a game they easily won 69-22 behind
8 a balanced effort that saw 12 players score; and

10 Sixteen in a hard-fought affair to Franklin County, the season was one of the finest in
11 school history, as it saw Simon Kenton win 28 games against just seven losses; and

13 teams who band together to achieve greatness in their sport; and

14 WHEREAS, in this spirit, the members congratulate the Simon Kenton High
15 School girls' basketball team upon winning the 8th Region Tournament and competing in
16 the Sweet Sixteen, acknowledge the hard work of the coaching staff for what it has
17 accomplished for these young women on and off the court, and commend the Simon
18 Kenton community for its ardent and passionate support of this extraordinary team;
