A RESOLUTION observing Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day in Kentucky
 and honoring Vietnam veterans for their courage and sacrifice while serving our great
 nation.

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2016, Governor Matt Bevin signed into law SB 178,
designating the thirtieth of March as Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day in the
Commonwealth of Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, there are over 125,000 Kentucky Vietnam veterans in the
Commonwealth, and they have contributed greatly to business, art, medicine, science,
technology, and government service; and

WHEREAS, more than 58,000 members of the United States Armed Forces,
including 1,103 from Kentucky, lost their lives in Vietnam, and more than 300,000
members of the Armed Forces were wounded; and

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Vietnam Veterans Memorial was dedicated in the city of
Frankfort to honor the 125,000 Kentuckians who served this nation so courageously and
unselfishly during the Vietnam era; and

WHEREAS, the Vietnam War was an extremely divisive issue among the people of the United States, and the crossfire of debate about the country's involvement in the war prevented many members of the Armed Forces from receiving the honor and respect they deserve; and

WHEREAS, although civil discourse about the political affairs of the United States should be encouraged, it is never too late to say, "I am sorry," and, "thank you," to our Vietnam veterans; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of Welcome Home Vietnam Veterans Day by the General Assembly in 2016 was an appropriate way to express appreciation and honor the members of the United States Armed Forces, as well as the members of service organizations who bravely served the country and their fellow citizens during the Vietnam War; and
