

1 A RESOLUTION remembering Joseph B. Mattingly.

2 WHEREAS, Joe Mattingly was born on March 29, 1917, in Marion County,
3 Kentucky; and

4 WHEREAS, Joe Mattingly moved to Fern Creek in Jefferson County and married
5 Gladys Browning in 1940; and

6 WHEREAS, during World War II, Joe Mattingly was employed for five years with
7 Naval Ordinance as a civilian. Multiple times he was drafted and attempted to volunteer
8 for active duty, but each time he was told his service was needed in the United States as a
9 civilian employee; and

10 WHEREAS, after the war, Joe Mattingly worked for thirty years for General
11 Electric; and

12 WHEREAS, Joe Mattingly and his wife were parents to fourteen children; and

13 WHEREAS, Joe Mattingly, a devoted steward of God and a cherished husband and
14 father, passed from this earthly life on January 20, 1999; and

15 WHEREAS, Joe Mattingly would have been 100 years old on March 29, 2017, and
16 it is appropriate that this honorable body commend him on this day for his many
17 contributions to his family, his community, and his beloved country;

18 NOW, THEREFORE,

19 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of*
20 *Kentucky:*

21 ➔Section 1. The members of the Senate hereby remember the extraordinary life
22 of Joseph B. Mattingly on what would have been his 100th birthday.

23 ➔Section 2. When the Senate adjourns this day, it does so in remembrance of and
24 eternal gratitude to Joseph B. Mattingly.
