

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the Senate in honor and loving memory of Lillian B.
2 Perkins.

3 WHEREAS, Lillian Perkins was a retired educator, having begun her career in a
4 one-room schoolhouse in Falmouth, Kentucky. She was hired as a full-time teacher in
5 1954 and retired in 1987 from Fayette County Schools after 36 years of meritorious
6 service; and

7 WHEREAS, Lillian Perkins was a proud volunteer for the American Red Cross, the
8 University of Kentucky Gift Shop, and the March of Dimes, and served as an ambassador
9 for the Lexington Convention and Visitors' Bureau and Host Committee; and

10 WHEREAS, Lillian Perkins was an active member of the Uttingertown Baptist
11 Church, serving as church clerk, chair of the Budget Committee, and chair and founder of
12 the Deacon James Perkins Scholarship Fund; and

13 WHEREAS, Lillian Perkins, beloved daughter, wife, aunt, and cousin, departed this
14 earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on February 1, 2017, leaving her
15 family, friends, and all those whose lives she touched in solemn mourning; and

16 WHEREAS, Lillian Perkins was preceded in death by her parents, Anna Simpson
17 Carsby and William B. Burdett, and her husband, Capt. James Perkins. She is survived by
18 her special niece, Anna Pearl Shaw, and a host of other family members, friends, and
19 loved ones who will dearly miss her presence in their lives;
