| 5  | WHEREAS, at 96 years young, Jack Baker is an expert angler who has earned the               |
| 6  | opportunity to catch muskie, having served in the United States Army in World War II,       |
| 7  | earning the World War II Victory Medal, European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign            |
| 8  | Medal, and Army Good Conduct Medal in addition to the Army marksmanship badge.              |
| 9  | Jack participated in the D-Day invasion of Nazi-occupied France in 1944; and                |
| 10 | WHEREAS, Jack Baker lost his son in a car crash in 1966, and his daughter and               |
| 11 | wife succumbed to cancer just three months apart in 2001. His niece, Sally Everman,         |
| 12 | works with the Legislative Research Commission; and   |
| 13 | WHEREAS, Jack Baker caught his first muskie in Tygarts Creek in 1950. Today, he             |
| 14 | still searches for muskie, using his South Bend Black Beauty rod and Abu Garcia             |
| 15 | baitcasting reel and decades of experience to find the fish. Each catch is released to swim |
| 16 | another day; and  |
| 17 | WHEREAS, the waters of Tygarts Creek, the Little Sandy River, and Kinniconick               |
| 18 | Creek are known to be among the Commonwealth's most beautiful watering holes and            |
| 19 | best places for muskie; and   |
| 20 | WHEREAS, Jack Baker and his white Chevrolet pickup truck are well-known to                  |
| 21 | local residents and often seen parked near a bridge on the road to Carter Caves State       |
| 22 | Resort Park; and  |
| 23 | WHEREAS, the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources honored                     |
| 24 | Jack Baker with an article about his life and fishing prowess in the Summer 2016 issue of   |
