3		→ Section 1. KRS 520.010 is amended to read as follows:
4	The	following definitions apply in this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
5	(1)	"Contraband" means any article or thing which a person confined in a detention
6		facility is prohibited from obtaining or possessing by statute, departmental
7		regulation, or posted institutional rule or order;
8	(2)	"Custody" means restraint by a public servant pursuant to a lawful arrest, detention
9		or an order of court for law enforcement purposes, but does not include supervision
10		of probation or parole or constraint incidental to release on bail;
11	(3)	"Dangerous contraband":
12		(a) Means contraband which is capable of use to endanger the safety or security of
13		a detention facility or persons therein, including, but not limited to, dangerous
14		instruments as defined in KRS 500.080, any controlled substances, any
15		quantity of an alcoholic beverage, [and] any quantity of marijuana, cell phones
16		not exempted in paragraph (b) of this subsection, and saws, files, and similar
17		metal cutting instruments; and
18		(b) Does not include cell phones if the person possessing a cell phone:
19		1. Is not detained within the detention facility;
20		2. Is present at the detention facility in a professional capacity; and
21		3. Maintains possession of the device at all times and does not permit
22		anyone detained within the detention facility to use the device;
23	(4)	"Detention facility" means any building and its premises used for the confinement
24		of a person:
25		(a) Charged with or convicted of an offense;
26		(b) Alleged or found to be delinquent;
27		(c) Held for extradition or as a material witness; or

1	(d) Otherwise confined pursuant to an order of court for law enforcement
2	purposes;
3	(5) "Escape" means departure from custody or the detention facility in which a person
4	is held or detained when the departure is unpermitted, or failure to return to custody
5	or detention following a temporary leave granted for a specific purpose or for a
6	limited period; and
7	(6) As used in this section and KRS 520.015, "penitentiary" includes any facility
8	operated by the Department of Corrections and the confines of any work detail or
9	other detail, whether under guard or not, under the custody and control of the
10	Department of Corrections.
11	→ SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 411 IS CREATED TO
12	READ AS FOLLOWS:
13	Jailers shall create policies in conformity with Section 1 of this Act governing
14	possession and use of cell phones within their jails by the jailer, deputy jailers,
15	attorneys, and those acting on their behalf. These policies shall be clearly stated and
16	posted in the entry of the jail and copies shall be made available to attorneys and those
17	acting on their behalf, upon request. These policies shall allow, but may provide
18	reasonable conditions upon, attorneys to use cell phones in connection with their
19	professional services in a detention facility.
