- "(2) (a) The circuit clerk's office shall disburse all collected reimbursement, restitution, and fees as ordered by the court[to the victim, the Kentucky Claims Commission, or the local government, whichever is appropriate]. The clerk shall be entitled to collect a fee[of two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50)] from each account for which a disbursement is made at the time of disbursement. The fee allowed under this paragraph shall be:
 - 1. Twenty dollars (\$20.00) where a disbursement by the circuit clerk's office is equal to or less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); or
 - 2. Fifty dollars (\$50.00) where the disbursement by the circuit clerk's office is greater than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000).
