| 3  | →SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 511 IS CREATED TO                    |

| 5  | (1) As used in this section:  |
| 6  | (a) "Key infrastructure assets" means:  |
| 7  | 1. Any critical node of a system used in the production or generation of      |
| 8  | electrical energy;  |
| 9  | 2. A petroleum refinery;  |
| 10 | 3. A rubber or hazardous chemical manufacturing facility;                     |
| 11 | 4. A petroleum or hazardous chemical storage facility or terminal;            |
| 12 | 5. Natural gas processing, fractionation, stabilization, and compressor       |
| 13 | station facilities, as well as above-ground pipelines and related             |
| 14 | <u>facilities;</u>  |
| 15 | 6. Railroad yards and railroad tunnel portals;                                |
| 16 | 7. A drinking water collection, treatment, or storage facility;               |
| 17 | 8. A facility used for research, development, design, production, delivery,   |
| 18 | or maintenance of military weapons systems, subsystems, and                   |
| 19 | components or parts to meet military requirements of the United               |
| 20 | States; or  |
| 21 | 9. A wireless communications facility, including the tower, antennae,         |
| 22 | support structures and all associated ground-based equipment, and a           |
| 23 | telecommunications central switching office; and                              |
| 24 | (b) "Unmanned aircraft system" means an aircraft that is operated without the |
| 25 | possibility of direct human interaction from within or on the aircraft and    |
| 26 | includes everything that is on board or otherwise attached to the aircraft    |
| 27 | and all associated elements, including communication links and the            |

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| 1  | components that control the small unmanned aircraft, that are required for         |
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| 2  | the safe and efficient operation of the unmanned aircraft in the national          |
| 3  | airspace system.   |
| 4  | (2) (a) A person commits the offense of trespass upon key infrastructure assets if |
| 5  | he or she knowingly enters or remains unlawfully in or upon real property          |
| 6  | on which key infrastructure assets are located.                                    |
| 7  | (b) A person commits the offense of trespass upon key infrastructure assets if     |
| 8  | <u>he or she knowingly uses, or retains or authorizes a person to use, an</u>      |
| 9  | <u>unmanned aircraft system to fly above real property on which key</u>            |
| 10 | infrastructure assets are located with the intent to cause harm or damage to       |
| 11 | or conduct surveillance of the key infrastructure asset without the prior          |
| 12 | consent of the owner, tenant, or lessee of the real property.                      |
| 13 | (3) Trespass upon key infrastructure assets is a Class B misdemeanor for the first |
| 14 | offense, and a Class A misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense.             |
| 15 | (4) This section does not apply to:  |
| 16 | (a) An unmanned aircraft system used by the federal government or by the           |
| 17 | Commonwealth, or by a person acting pursuant to a contract with the                |
| 18 | federal government or the Commonwealth;  |
| 19 | (b) An unmanned aircraft system used by:   |
| 20 | 1. The owner of the real property or key infrastructure asset;                     |
| 21 | 2. A person under a valid lease, servitude, right-of-way, right of use,            |
| 22 | permit, license, or other right granted by the owner of the real                   |
| 23 | property or key infrastructure asset; or   |
| 24 | 3. A third party who is retained or authorized by a person specified in            |
| 25 | subparagraph 1. or 2. of this paragraph;   |
| 26 | (c) An unmanned aircraft system used by a law enforcement agency,                  |
| 27 | <u>emergency medical service agency, hazardous material response team,</u>         |

| 7  | <u>(e)</u> | A satellite orbiting the earth;  |
| 8  | <u>(f)</u> | An unmanned aircraft system used by an insurance company or a person       |
| 9  |            | acting on behalf of an insurance company for purposes of underwriting an   |
| 10 |            | insurance risk or investigating damage to insured property; or             |
| 11 | <u>(g)</u> | An unmanned aircraft system used strictly in accordance with an order of a |
| 12 |            | court of competent jurisdiction.   |
