- (b) Breech presentation;
 - (c) Previous cesarean section;
 - (d) Previous shoulder dystocia;
 - (e) Gestational diabetes;
 - (f) Preeclampsia; or
 - (g) Any other high-risk pregnancy or neonatal condition that would preclude a safe birth.
- (2) In accordance with KRS 311.723, a certified professional midwife issued a permit by the board in accordance with Sections 1 to 7 of this Act shall not perform an abortion.
- (3) Any person convicted of violating subsection (2) of this section shall be guilty of a Class D felony."
