<u>(1)</u>	Beginning with the entering ninth grade class of the 2020-2021 school year and
	each year thereafter, successful completion of one (1) or more courses or
	programs that meet the financial literacy standards shall be a Kentucky public
	high school graduation requirement. The graduation requirement shall also
	apply to a student pursuing an early graduation program, as established in KRS
	<u>158.142.</u>
<u>(2)</u>	In accordance with KRS 156.160, the Kentucky Board of Education shall
	promulgate administrative regulations establishing academic standards and a
	graduation requirement for financial literacy.
<u>(3)</u>	The local school-based decision making council, or principal if no council exists,
	of each high school shall determine curricula for course offerings, programs, or
	a combination of course offerings and programs that are aligned with the
	financial literacy academic standards promulgated by the Kentucky Board of
	Education.
<i>(4)</i>	The Department of Education shall develop financial literacy guidelines that
	provide direction to local schools in developing and implementing the financial
	literacy standards.
