1	AN ACT relating to Kentucky school bus drivers.
2	WHEREAS, every day public school is in session, in darkness and daylight, bitter
3	cold and brutal heat, and in rain, snow, or sunshine, Kentucky's school bus drivers travel
4	on dirt roads and multi-lane highways to deliver the Commonwealth's school children to
5	their places of learning and to their homes again on schedule; and
6	WHEREAS, the breadth and scope of that responsibility is great and the hours
7	difficult; and
8	WHEREAS, the position of a school bus driver requires tremendous maturity and
9	responsibility, with the ability to drive safely through traffic, regardless of the weather or
10	road conditions, while maintaining the proper conduct of the children in his or her care
11	and providing life-saving leadership in the event of emergencies; and
12	WHEREAS, America's 440,000 school buses comprise the largest mass
13	transportation fleet in the country, more than two and a half times the size of all other
14	forms of mass transportation combined; and
15	WHEREAS, Kentucky's school districts often encompass large geographic areas,
16	necessitating extensive use of school buses to transport students; and
17	WHEREAS, each school day, approximately 675,000 public school students and
18	their parents rely upon dependable school bus service, which a school district provides;
19	and
20	WHEREAS, there are more than 11,000 licensed school bus drivers in the
21	Commonwealth, operating more than 10,000 registered school buses that travel more than
22	115 million miles each year; and
23	WHEREAS, the National Traffic Highway Safety Administration has documented
24	the far smaller number of accidents and fatalities per capita on school buses than in
25	automobiles driven by either students or parents; and
26	WHEREAS, school bus drivers are an important component in overall student and
27	community safety with their knowledge of their neighborhoods and their ability to observe

1 suspicious activity or people along their bus routes and communicate that information to

- 2 the proper authorities; and
- WHEREAS, Kentucky's school bus drivers are dedicated to performing their duties
- 4 in a safe, courteous, and professional manner;
- 5 NOW, THEREFORE,
- 6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- 7 → SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 2 IS CREATED TO
- 8 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 9 The first day of May each year is designated and shall be observed in Kentucky as
- 10 <u>"School Bus Driver Day."</u>
