**UNOFFICIAL COPY** 

1	AN ACT relating to physical therapist licensure and declaring an emergency.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→ SECTION 1. KRS 327.310 IS REPEALED AND REENACTED TO READ AS
4	FOLLOWS:
5	The Board of Physical Therapy established in KRS 327.030 shall require a national
6	and state criminal background investigation for every applicant seeking a license,
7	certificate, or temporary permit issued by the board permitting the applicant to engage
8	in a profession authorized by the board. The criminal background investigation shall
9	be by means of a fingerprint check by the Department of Kentucky State Police and
10	Federal Bureau of Investigation, pursuant to the following requirements:
11	(1) The applicant shall provide his or her fingerprints to the Department of Kentucky
12	State Police for submission to the Federal Bureau of Investigation after a state
13	criminal background check is conducted;
14	(2) The results of the national and state criminal background check shall be sent to
15	the board for the screening of applicants;
16	(3) The board shall be prohibited from releasing any criminal history record
17	information to any private entity or other licensing board, or authorizing receipt
18	by such entity or board; and
19	(4) Any fee charged by the Department of Kentucky State Police or the Federal
20	Bureau of Investigation shall be an amount no greater than the actual cost of
21	processing the request and conducting the background check. The board may
22	charge this fee to the applicant for licensure or certification.
23	$\Rightarrow$ Section 2. Whereas, the Federal Bureau of Investigation has deemed the
24	criminal background check procedures of KRS Chapter 327 insufficient to meet its
25	standards, and failure to change these background check procedures before May 2018
26	could risk Kentucky's membership in the Physical Therapy Licensure Compact, an
27	emergency is declared to exist, and this Act takes effect upon its passage and approval by
