6		subdivision thereof, performing his or her official duties within the course and
7		scope of his or her employment;
8	(2)	A public accountant, certified public accountant, or the bona fide employee of
9		either, performing duties within the scope of public accountancy;
10	(3)	A person engaged exclusively in the business of obtaining and furnishing
11		information regarding the financial rating or standing and credit of persons;
12	(4)	An attorney-at-law[, or an attorney's bona fide employee,] performing duties within
13		the scope of the practice of law or <i>an attorney's bona fide employee or</i> authorized
14		agent <i>performing</i> [ with duties limited to] document and record retrieval or witness
15		interviews;
16	(5)	An insurance company, licensed insurance agent, staff or independent adjuster if
17		authorized to do business in Kentucky, or an individual employed by an insurance
18		company or licensed insurance agent to investigate suspected fraudulent insurance
19		claims, but who does not adjust losses or determine claims payments, performing
20		investigative duties limited to matters strictly pertaining to an insurance transaction;
21	(6)	A person engaged in compiling genealogical information, or otherwise tracing
22		lineage or ancestry, by primarily utilizing public records and historical information
23		or databases;
24	(7)	A private business employee conducting <i>internal</i> investigations relating to the
25		<u>business</u> [ company] entity by which he or she is employed;
26	(8)	[An individual obtaining information or conducting investigations on his or her own

1	(9) ]An employee of a private investigator or a private investigating firm <u>licensed by</u>
2	the board and working [ who works] under the direction of the private investigator
3	or the private investigating firm. To protect the public from unprofessional,
4	improper, incompetent, unlawful, fraudulent, or deceptive activity, the board
5	<u>shall promulgate administrative regulations to establish a reasonable fee,</u>
6	registration process, and minimum eligibility criteria for any such employee. The
7	board shall maintain an active registry of all such employees [ for less than two
8	hundred forty (240) hours per year. The board shall promulgate administrative
9	regulations to establish a method of verification of the number of hours worked];
