10	WHEREAS, KRS and TRS include nearly 550,000 members, former members, and
11	retirees who rely upon these contractually and morally promised benefits to meet their
12	needs during their retirement years; and
13	WHEREAS, KRS and TRS members and retired members have faithfully paid their
14	required statutory contribution rate each pay period during their working careers as public
15	servants; and
16	WHEREAS, the funding problems facing KRS and TRS were not caused by KRS
17	and TRS employees and retirees; and
18	WHEREAS, teachers and retired teachers do not participate in Social Security
19	coverage and rely solely upon their TRS benefits during their retirement years; and
20	WHEREAS, the Commonwealth has a responsibility to protect those who protect
21	us, who teach our children and grandchildren, and who faithfully serve the needs of the
22	Commonwealth on a daily basis;
23	NOW, THEREFORE,
