

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION directing the Transportation Cabinet to erect signs in
2 honor of the Lynn Camp High School Cheer Team, 2018 All "A" State Cheerleading
3 Champions.

4 WHEREAS, on January 25th, at McBrayer Arena at Eastern Kentucky University,
5 the Lynn Camp High School Cheer Team competed in the in-game competition during
6 the first round of the Boys All "A" Classic; and

7 WHEREAS, the Lynn Camp High School Cheer Team was victorious against 15
8 other squads, winning the school's first ever All "A" State Cheerleading Championship;

10 WHEREAS, recently the Lynn Camp High School Cheer Team was also crowned
11 13th Region Small Varsity Competitive Cheerleading Champions; and

12 WHEREAS, the General Assembly hereby salutes the achievements of the Lynn
13 Camp High School Cheer Team: Amber Garrison, Jayden Jones, Kaylan Brown,
14 Cheyenne Hopkins, Erin Holland, Shyanne Parker, Brooklyn Garland, Solara Marlow,
15 Zola Frye, Hayleigh Duff, Sydney Messer, Hailee Bright, Sadie Mabe, Bethany Smith and
16 coach, Paula Grubb;

17 NOW, THEREFORE,

18 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

19 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is directed to honor the Lynn Camp High
20 School Cheer Team by placing honorary signs on United States Highway 25E, at the
21 Knox County/Bell County line and the Knox County/Laurel County line that read, "Home
22 of the Lynn Camp HS Cheer Team 2018 All "A" State Champions." The signs shall be
23 erected within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution and shall remain in place
24 for at least one year from the date of their placement.
