

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a bridge in Knott County, Kentucky, in honor  
2 and memory of George H. Gayheart.

3 WHEREAS, George H. Gayheart was born August 14, 1920, in the tranquil town of  
4 Cordia in Knott County; and

5 WHEREAS, George H. Gayheart was a World War II veteran who earned the rank  
6 of Staff Sergeant, as well as two bronze stars and the Purple Heart, for his courageous  
7 works; and

8 WHEREAS, George H. Gayheart was a longtime member of the Lotts Creek  
9 Evangelical Free Church; and

10 WHEREAS, after his service to our country, George H. Gayheart had a long career  
11 as an employee of General Telephone & Electric Corporation; and

12 WHEREAS, George H. Gayheart was a respected member of the Union Local  
13 10371 Communication Workers of America; and

14 WHEREAS, George H. Gayheart departed this earthly life on September 18, 1992;

16 WHEREAS, George H. Gayheart was preceded in death by his wife, Maxine  
17 Gayheart. He is survived by his children, Cassandra Eline Gayheart, Susan Hobbs, Jonny  
18 Jo Gayheart, George Delynn Gayheart, and Rex Doyle Gayheart;

20 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

21 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to designate the bridge  
22 on Kentucky Route 1088, at the Perry County/Knott County line as the "George H.  
23 Gayheart Memorial Bridge," and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this  
24 Resolution, erect the appropriate signage.
