

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a portion of Kentucky Route 160 in Harlan  
2 County in honor of SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel.

3 WHEREAS, SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel served in the United States Army with  
4 Headquarters Company, 1st Battalion, 6th Infantry Regiment, 1st Armored Division,  
5 Fourth United States Army, Fort Hood, Texas, from August 1961 until August 1963; and

6 WHEREAS, after being discharged from active duty, SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel  
7 was assigned to the United States Army Reserve for annual training with the United  
8 States Army Control Group; and

9 WHEREAS, SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel operated the Tri-City Funeral Home from  
10 1962 until his death on April 4, 2014; and

11 WHEREAS, SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel was a dedicated community leader, feeding  
12 senior citizens twice a year at the Lynch Church of God and also on Thanksgiving and  
13 Christmas, and contributing in other ways too numerous to mention; and

14 WHEREAS, SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel was a dedicated Christian, soldier, husband,  
15 father, grandfather, and great-grandfather who was a friend to many and whose character  
16 and loyalty were never in question; and

17 WHEREAS, SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel served the people of the Tri-City with honor  
18 and dignity; and

19 WHEREAS, through this designation the General Assembly seeks to honor the life  
20 and service of SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel;

21 NOW, THEREFORE,

22 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

23 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet shall designate Kentucky Route 160,  
24 from the entrance to Benham to the bridge by the Benham Post Office, in Harlan County,  
25 as the "SP4 Bobby Lewis Manuel Memorial Highway," and shall, within 30 days of the  
26 effective date of this Resolution, erect the appropriate signage.
