

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION directing the Transportation Cabinet to erect signs
2 declaring Metcalfe County as the "Home of Molly Matney, 2017 Miss Kentucky."

3 WHEREAS, on July 1, 2017, Molly Matney, Miss Mammoth Cave Area, was
4 crowned Miss Kentucky 2017; and

5 WHEREAS, Molly Matney is the daughter of Rhonda and Avery Matney; and

6 WHEREAS, Molly Matney is a 20-year-old Senior at Western Kentucky University
7 majoring in Agriculture; and

8 WHEREAS, growing up on a beef cattle farm in rural Kentucky, Molly Matney
9 developed a passion for agriculture at an early age; and

10 WHEREAS, as Miss Kentucky, Molly Matney serves as the spokesperson for the
11 Kentucky Department of Agriculture to promote the importance of buying healthy, fresh
12 foods produced across the state; and

13 WHEREAS, speaking to children in schools throughout the Commonwealth about
14 where their food comes from is Molly Matney's passion; and

15 WHEREAS, Molly Matney wants to inspire others to live a lifestyle that is
16 unbelievably full, healthy, and wholesome;

17 NOW, THEREFORE,

18 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

19 ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to honor Molly Matney
20 by erecting signs on Kentucky Route 314 in Metcalfe County, at mile point 3.241 and mile
21 point 6.463, that read "Home of Molly Matney 2017 Miss Kentucky." The signs shall be
22 erected within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution and shall remain in place for
23 at least one year from the date of their placement.
