

1 A JOINT RESOLUTION designating a portion of Kentucky Route 100 in Allen  
2 County in honor and memory of Jeffrey P. Anderson.

3 WHEREAS, Jeffrey P. Anderson was born on November 12, 1978, the cherished  
4 son of Roger and Lisa Martin; and

5 WHEREAS, Jeffrey P. Anderson was an employee of the City of Scottsville for  
6 three years; and

7 WHEREAS, Jeffrey P. Anderson tragically departed this earthly life on September  
8 26, 2017, after being struck by a vehicle while performing his job in Scottsville; and

9 WHEREAS, Jeffrey P. Anderson was remembered as "a good guy...was friendly  
10 with everyone...was always smiling and waving and was a happy person" by his family  
11 and friends; and

12 WHEREAS, Jeffrey P. Anderson will be greatly missed by his family, friends, and  
13 all those whose lives he touched with his warm smile, his graciousness, and his passion  
14 for life; and

15 WHEREAS, Jeffrey P. Anderson was preceded in death by his maternal  
16 grandparents, Paul and Lorene Anderson; his paternal grandfather, Garnett Martin; his  
17 nephew, Jacob Tabbert; and his sister-in-law, Tammy Denise Tucker. He is survived by  
18 his loving wife of 11 years, Ruthie Rena Perry Anderson; his beloved sons, Kayden  
19 Anderson and Jordan Anderson; his parents; his sister, Melissa Tabbert and her husband,

27 ***Be it resolved by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:***

1           ➔Section 1. The Transportation Cabinet is hereby directed to designate Kentucky  
2 Route 100 in Allen County, from mile point 15.2 to mile point 15.4, as the "Jeffrey P.  
3 Anderson Highway" and shall, within 30 days of the effective date of this Resolution,  
4 erect appropriate signage.
