

1 A RESOLUTION establishing the 2018 membership of the Kentucky State House of
2 Representatives.

3 WHEREAS, the Secretary of State has previously certified to the House of
4 Representatives the results of the 2016 regular elections; and

5 WHEREAS, under Sections 38, 39, and 43 of the Kentucky Constitution, the House
6 of Representatives must judge the elections, qualifications, and returns of the
7 Representatives therein; and

8 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives desires to establish the duly elected
9 membership of the 2018 Kentucky State House of Representatives;

10 NOW, THEREFORE,

11 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the*
12 *Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

13 ➔Section 1. The House of Representatives accepts the certificates of election as
14 transmitted by the Kentucky Secretary of State and hereby finds these certificates to be
15 proper and in order, and they shall be accepted. The House of Representatives finds that
16 these members meet the qualifications as stated in the Kentucky Constitution.
