WHEREAS, Dr. Jimmy Carter was a son of this Commonwealth, having been born
in Monroe County on December 12, 1932, to the late Evelyn and Abe Parker Carter; and
WHEREAS, Dr. Carter proudly served as a physician in Tompkinsville for half a
century. In 2007, he was named one of America's top doctors, and at the end of his career
he was recognized by the American Academy of Family Physicians for his 50 years of
service; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Carter was a treasure of his community, and throughout his 10 accomplished life he gave back to the people of Tompkinsville and Monroe County. Dr. 11 Carter was a charter member of Tompkinsville First Baptist Church; served on the Tri-12 County Electric Co-Op Board as Director of the Tompkinsville District for 18 years; and 13 also served on the Monroe County Board of Education for 38 years, 34 of those as chair. 14 At the time of his passing, he was chair of the Monroe County Republican Party, and was 15 a founding member of the Monroe County Historical Society; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Carter, beloved physician and cherished husband, father, and grandfather, departed this earthly life and entered into the kingdom of Heaven on February 12, 2018, leaving his family, friends, and all those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and
