1	A RESOLUTION recognizing March 11, 2018, as Mountain Dulcimer Day in
2	Kentucky.
3	WHEREAS, the Mountain Dulcimer is renowned for its heritage that stems from
4	the scattered settlements of the Appalachian Mountains, and is known as one of the
5	earliest examples of cultural diversity that encompasses several settlements of the
6	Appalachian region; and
7	WHEREAS, acclaimed to be the melody of many within the Southern Appalachian
8	culture, the Mountain Dulcimer is often deemed the Kentucky Dulcimer. James Edward
9	Thomas, a son of Kentucky, was credited for being the premier dulcimer maker in the late
10	1870s until his passing in 1933; and
11	WHEREAS, Kentuckians such as Bristol Taylor, Jethro Amburgey, Homer C.
12	Ledford, John Tignor, Warren A. May, and many more continued the legacy of making
13	dulcimers. The instrument is continually reinvented by makers to preserve the uniqueness
14	of its melody; and
15	WHEREAS, the late Jean Ritchie, a native of Viper, Kentucky, revived the musical
16	lap instrument in Eastern Kentucky approximately in the early 1940s through the folk
17	music revival scene; and
18	WHEREAS, the revival of the Mountain Dulcimer enabled players to evolve their
19	technique and repertoire from the traditional ranges founded in the mountains; and
20	WHEREAS, today, the current repertoire of players ranges from party and play
21	songs of the Celtic countries, minstrel tunes, gospel, blues, and many more to illustrate
22	the historic culture of the Mountain Dulcimer; and
23	WHEREAS, the Hindman Settlement School and Appalachian Artisan Center in
24	Hindman, Kentucky are pivotal in preserving and promoting the cultural heritage of the
25	Central Appalachian region which ensures that the Mountain Dulcimer and the legacy
26	illustrated within its melody will be everlasting;
