

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor and loving
2 memory of Joseph Lee Nally.

3 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was born to the late JH and Magdline Nally; and

4 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was a lifelong western Kentucky farmer and pioneer
5 independent oil producer, and was known for his various enterprises, including Joseph
6 Lee Nally Drilling; and

7 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally also owned and operated CountryMark Retail Gas
8 Fueling Station under Union Products, Inc., and Union Fuel, Inc., which was the first of
9 its kind to be established in the Commonwealth of Kentucky; this station acts as a much-
10 needed resource and center for the community in Uniontown, Kentucky; and

11 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was a key employer to twelve within the Union
12 County community; and

13 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was a member of St. Agnes Roman Catholic Church,
14 and loved to participate in festivals and fundraising; and

15 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was a contributor to the successful construction and
16 launching of John Paul II Catholic School in Morganfield, Kentucky; and

17 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was a member of Knights of Columbus; and

18 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was a member of Holy Name Society; and

19 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was a member of Kentucky Farm Bureau in Union
20 County; and

21 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was a past member of the Kentucky Oil and Gas
22 Association, which recognizes Mr. Nally as an important piece and advocate of
23 Kentucky's oil production industry and history; and

24 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally departed this earthly life on February 24, 2018,
25 leaving those whose lives he touched in solemn mourning; and

26 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally was preceded in death by his parents; sister, Dorothy
27 Braddock; and grandchild, Mary Therese McGrath; and

1 WHEREAS, Joseph Lee Nally is survived by his loving wife of 55 years, Betty
2 Nally; sons, Mark A. (Donna) Nally and John E. (Scherrie) Nally; daughter, Sherri
3 (Brendan) McGrath; grandchildren, Amanda Casey, Ryan Nally, Theresa McGrath,
4 Thomas McGrath, Jaci Utley, Chase Nally, Shelby Hite, Samuel Hite, and Bryce Nally;
5 three great-grandchildren; brother, Wayne Nally; and sister, Patsy Girten;
