A RESOLUTION designating the month of March in each year as "Sexual
 Harassment Awareness Month" in Kentucky.

3 WHEREAS, our society is in the midst of a time of sea change with regard to 4 sexual harassment, as a record number of victims have found the courage and strength to 5 use their voices to topple powerful abusers, harassers, and assailants; and

6 WHEREAS, sexual harassment affects both women and men, regardless of race, 7 socioeconomic status, level of education, age, or sexual orientation, with over half of all 8 women and one-third of all men reporting that they have been the victim of some form of 9 sexual harassment in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, 65 percent of women and 25 percent of men report being sexually harassed in public spaces other than their place of work, including on public transportation, on airplanes, at sporting events, and while simply walking down the street; and

WHEREAS, the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission reported that approximately one-third of the 90,000 complaints it received in 2015 included allegations of sexual harassment, and

WHEREAS, the EEOC estimates that 75 percent of harassment incidents gounreported; and

WHEREAS, as 75 percent of victims who have found the courage and strength toreport their abuse also experience some form of retaliation; and

WHEREAS, sexual harassment can result in long-term physical and psychological
 consequences for the victim, including depression, anxiety, post-traumatic stress disorder,
 and even suicide; and

WHEREAS, sexual harassment can cause significant financial harm to both victims and their employers through job turnover, use of paid and unpaid sick leave, losses in individual and workgroup productivity, legal fees, and legal settlements; and

27 WHEREAS, shame, fear, and cultural norms allow sexual harassment to occur and
