17	way for those who now benefit from their sacrifice, their courage, and their vision
18	including women in this chamber; and
19	WHEREAS, the body finally affirms the many hopes and dreams of those little girls
20	who yearn to break through ceilings those who came before them never thought possible;
21	NOW, THEREFORE,
22	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the
23	Commonwealth of Kentucky:
24	→ Section 1. The members of the House of Representatives, both individually and
25	collectively, hereby recognize March 8, 2018, as International Women's Day.
