1	A RESOLUTION encouraging Kentucky grocers to offer paper grocery bags as an
2	alternative to plastic grocery bags.
3	WHEREAS, forests cover nearly one-half of Kentucky and provide a wide range of
4	both economic and noneconomic benefits to the Commonwealth; and
5	WHEREAS, the primary economic contributor of Kentucky forests is derived from
6	the utilization of timber and wood resources; and
7	WHEREAS, according to the University of Kentucky's 2015 Forestry Economic
8	Impact Report, Kentucky's forest and wood industries employ over 28,000 individuals
9	and have an estimated direct economic impact of \$9.1 billion and a total economic impact
10	of \$14.6 billion; and
11	WHEREAS, the huge economic impact of the forest and wood industries is
12	generated from forests located in all 120 counties of the Commonwealth providing
13	resources harvested by over 1,200 logging firms and processed at 713 facilities located in
14	109 counties including sawmills, pulp mills, and paper mills; and
15	WHEREAS, paper represents a sizeable portion of Kentucky's forestry sector at an
16	estimated \$5.2 billion overall, including pulp and paper manufacturing and paper
17	converters; and
18	WHEREAS, a young forest is a lesser known but equally important type of habitat
19	that is created by shoots and sprouts of young trees from the root systems of older trees
20	following timber harvests like those necessary for the production of wood pulp and paper
21	products; and
22	WHEREAS, young forests created by timber harvests are essential to the survival of
23	many rare and common species of wildlife including bobcats, ruffed grouse, wood turtles,
24	wild turkeys, and a wide variety of songbirds; and
25	WHEREAS, paper grocery bags are a heavier-duty alternative to single-use plastic
26	bags for packing, transporting, and unloading customer purchases; and
27	WHEREAS, increased use of and demand for paper grocery bags would almost

- 5 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the

- 8 grocery bags to customers as an alternative to plastic single-use grocery bags in order to
- 9 help support and further grow the Kentucky pulp and paper industry.
