

1 A RESOLUTION celebrating Girl Scout Day.

2 WHEREAS, March 12, 2018, marks the 106th anniversary of the Girl Scouts of the
3 United States of America, which was founded by Juliette Gordon Low in 1912 in
4 Savannah, Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, throughout its distinguished history, the Girl Scouts have inspired
6 millions of girls and women with the highest ideals of courage, confidence, and character;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, through the Girl Scout leadership experience, girls develop the skills
9 and lessons that will serve them for a lifetime so that they may contribute to their
10 communities; and

11 WHEREAS, Girl Scouting takes an active role in increasing girls' awareness of the
12 opportunities available to them today in math, science, technology, healthy living, and
13 other fields that can expand their horizons and strengthen the Commonwealth of
14 Kentucky; and

15 WHEREAS, the overarching mission of the Girl Scouts is to build girls' courage,
16 confidence, and character in an effort to make the world a better place; and

17 WHEREAS, Girl Scouts of the USA is the preeminent leadership development
18 organization for girls that offers programs in every state and across the globe; and

19 WHEREAS, on March 12, 2018, the Girl Scouts will celebrate Girl Scout Day at
20 the State Capitol. This honorable body recognizes all those Girl Scouts in attendance,
21 rightfully celebrates the rich history of the Girl Scouts, and acknowledges the profound
22 importance of the Girl Scouts in their mission to support the leadership development of
23 America's girls;

24 NOW, THEREFORE,

25 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the*
26 *Commonwealth of Kentucky:*

27 ➔Section 1. The House of Representatives is pleased to recognize Girl Scout Day

1 and proudly celebrates the history of the Girl Scouts of the United States of America upon
2 its 106th anniversary.

3 ➔Section 2. When the House of Representatives adjourns this day, it does so in
4 honor of Girl Scout Day.
