

1 A RESOLUTION adjourning the House of Representatives in honor and loving
2 memory of Gordon "Colonel" Brown.

3 WHEREAS, Gordon "Colonel" Brown was born in Clarksburg, Kentucky, on
4 September 15, 1924, to the late Randolph and Minnie Gulley Brown; and

5 WHEREAS, Colonel Brown proudly served his country in the United States Army
6 with the 10th Mountain Division in World War II. After his service, he was a member of
7 the Monte Lewis Stamm Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 5438; and

8 WHEREAS, Colonel Brown retired from the Lewis County School system as a
9 vocational auto body instructor; and

10 WHEREAS, Colonel Brown hosted Colonel Brown's Classic Country program on
11 WKKS Radio. He also wrote "The Colonel's Corner" column for The Lewis County
12 Herald; and

13 WHEREAS, as a lifelong musician, Colonel Brown and his wife of 72 years,
14 Dorothy "Dot" Brown, owned and operated the Fly Branch Jamboree; and

15 WHEREAS, Colonel Brown shared his life with his church family at Clarksburg
16 Church of Christ; and

17 WHEREAS, Colonel Brown departed this earthly life on March 10, 2018, leaving
18 his family, his friends, and his community in solemn mourning; and

19 WHEREAS, Colonel Brown is survived by his wife, Dot; his daughter, Dottie
20 Logan; his two sons, Randy Brown and Dennis Brown; his five grandchildren, Brent
21 Logan, Ashley Dillow, Lindsey Brown, Kaitlin Brown, and Ben Brown; and four great-
22 grandchildren. He was preceded in death by a son, Allen Brown, and a child at birth;
23 three sisters, Carrie Bell Edington, Mary Etta Brown, and Nettie Dyer; and three brothers,
24 John Brown, Alvin Brown, and Bert Brown;
